



# Medicare Criteria

## Continuous Glucose Monitoring Therapy

According to the U.S. Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), patients must have Type 1 or Type 2 diabetes, intensively manage their insulin, and meet all of the following eligibility criteria to get a Therapeutic CGM covered by Medicare.

The physician must submit a completed [CGM Certificate of Medical Necessity/Letter of Medical Necessity](#) and office/progress notes\* that state:

- ◆ The patient has diabetes mellitus
- ◆ The patient has been testing four or more times a day
- ◆ The patient uses three or more daily injections (MDI) or an insulin pump
- ◆ The treatment regimen requires the patient to frequently adjust based on the therapeutic CGM testing results
- ◆ The patient has seen his/her doctor in the last six months

### Important Notes:

Office/progress notes must be dated before the CMN/LMN.

To remain eligible, the patient must see his/her doctor every six months to evaluate the CGM therapy.
